We have responsibility to ensure that the students should be given supervision, assistance and advice that they need to be benefitted from the excellent facilities at **Bright Star Central Academy.**

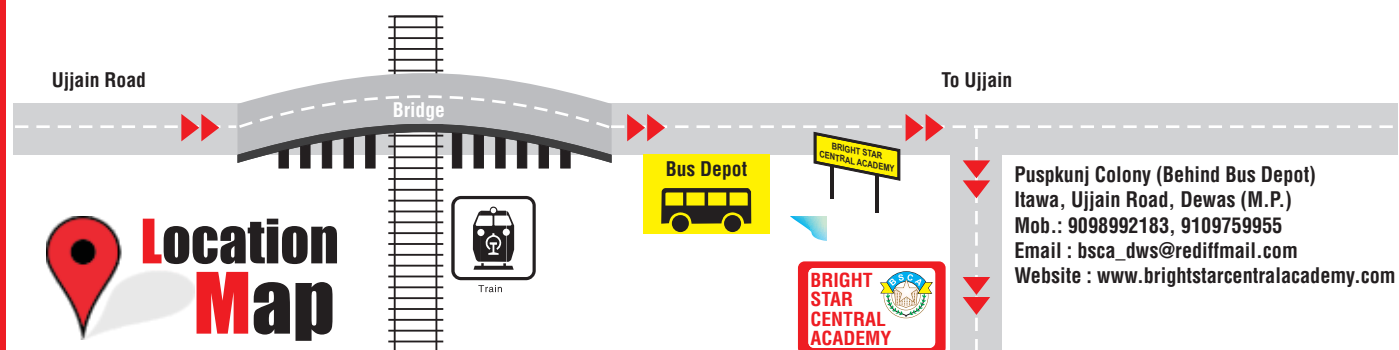
The school campus is nearly about in 4.5 acres with a huge building having all facilities, which the students need for his/her life slab.

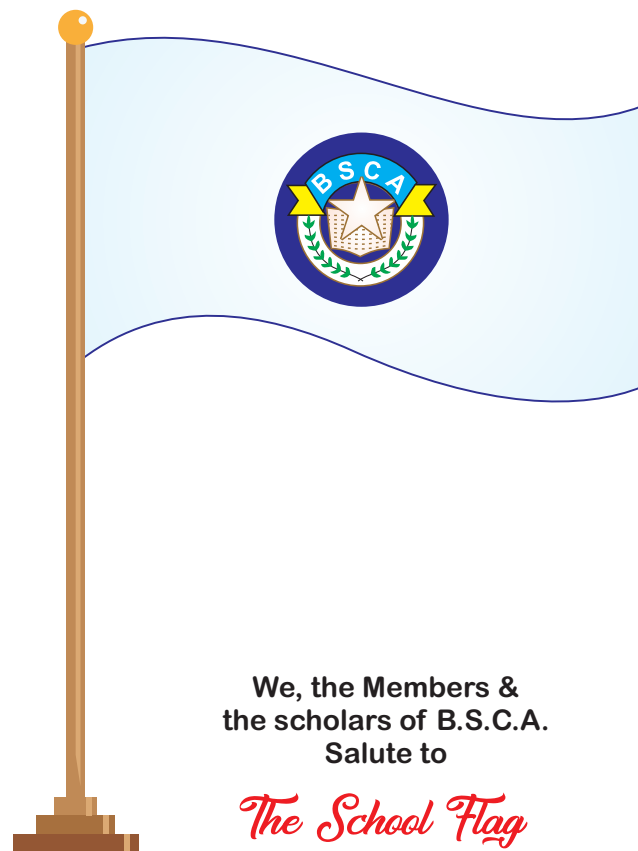

## *Parental Co-operation*



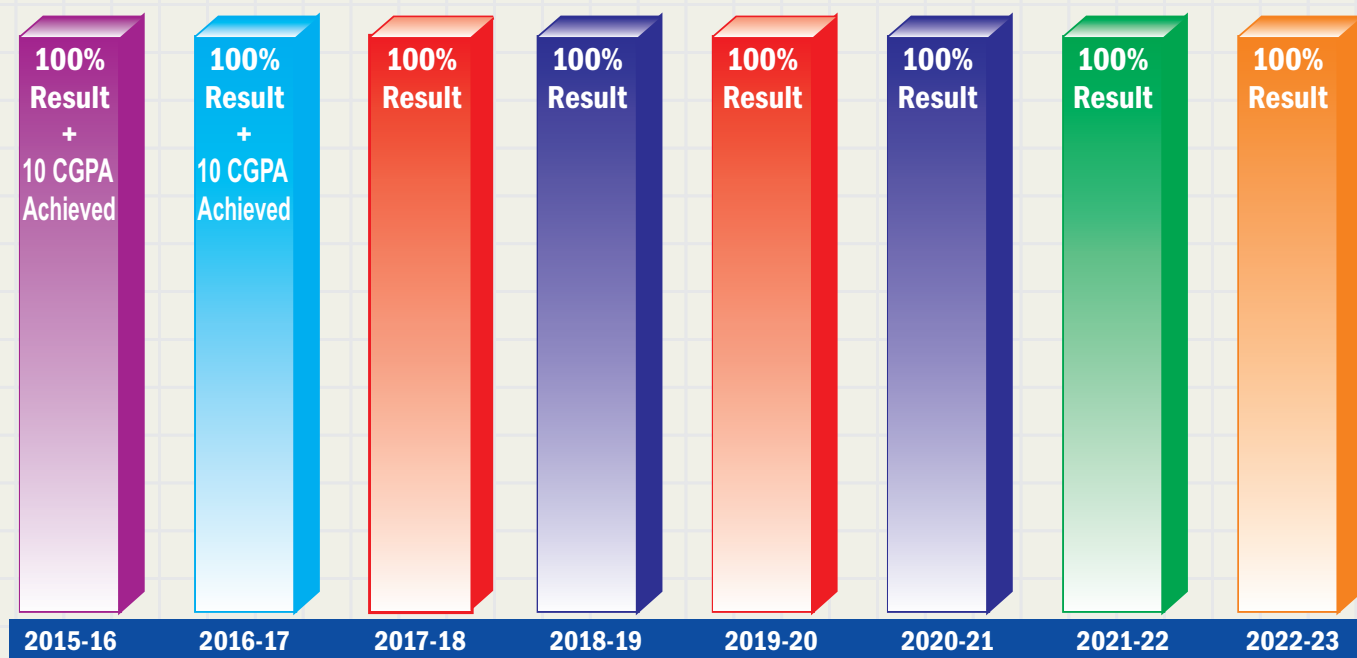
1. Parents should visit in the school office whenever they are called.

## *Rules and Regulations of the School*

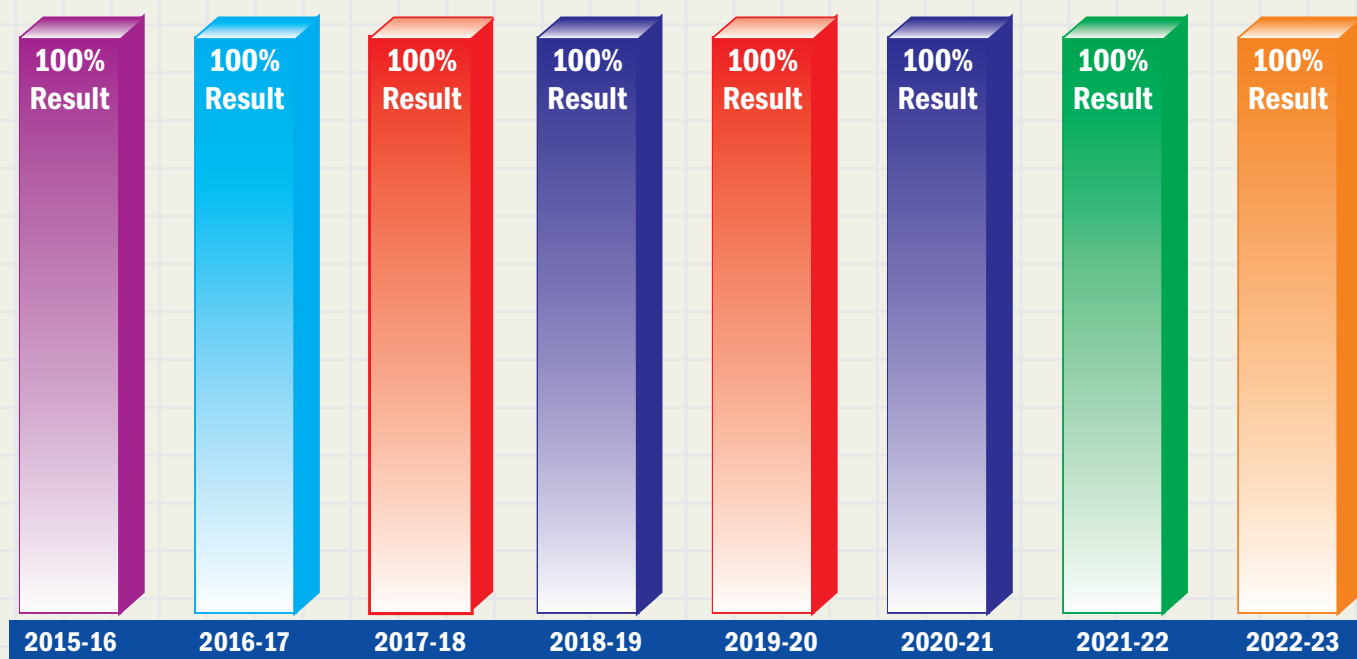
1. Every student is expected to behave properly in a disciplined way.
